Schools Experience Crisis & Traumatic Events Every Year

Crises and traumatic events such as school violence, staff or student death, or other accidents pose a real challenge for students and communities. Like all public schools, it is important for charter schools to be able to address school crises and traumatic events with services and professionals that provide support, guidance, and resources to affected students, staff, and families.

Who Is the MACS School Crisis Response Team?

The MACS School Crisis Response Team is composed of volunteer professionals from charter schools who have been trained in Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) to provide on-site support to those affected by crisis and traumatic events.

What Is MACS School Crisis Response Team Training?

The training will focus on three common phases of a crisis: 1) pre-crisis planning, 2) acute crisis response, and 3) post-crisis activities. Participants will be introduced to Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) and specific, effective, research-informed intervention techniques. Participants will explore the elements of effective crisis management through multiple group activities spread over two days and leave with access to a variety of useful materials.
