CATEGORY REFERENCE SHEET

CATEGORY A

Relevant coursework completed at an accredited college or university.

- A transcript from the college or university must be provided
- 1 Semester Credit = 24 Clock Hours
- 1 Quarter Credit = 16 Clock Hours

CATEGORY B

Educational workshops, conferences, institutes, seminars, or lectures in areas appropriate to license(s) held.

CATEGORY C

Staff development activities, in-service meetings, and in-service courses.

CATEGORY D

Site, district, state, national, or international curriculum development (does not include regular lesson planning).

CATEGORY E

Engagement in formal peer coaching or mentorship relationships that address one or more of the standards in Board of Teaching Rule 8710.2000.

CATEGORY F

Professional experiences such as:

- Supervision of clinical experience of persons enrolled in Teacher Preparation Programs
- Membership on national, state, and local committees involved with licensure, teacher education, or professional standards (includes charter school board service
- Participation in national, regional, or state accreditation

CATEGORY G

Leadership experiences such as:

- Development of new or broader skills and sensitivities to the school, community, or profession
- Publication of professional articles in a professional journal in an appropriate field
- Volunteer work in professional organizations related to field of licensure

CATEGORY H

Opportunities to enhance knowledge and understanding of diverse educational settings such as:

- · Experiences with students of another age, ability level, culture, or socioeconomic background
- Systematic, purposeful observation during visits to other schools and to related business/industry

CATEGORY I

Pre-approved travel or work experience such as:

- Travel for purposes of improving instructional capabilities related to the field of licensure
- Work experience in business/industry appropriate to field of licensure

NOTE: One week of pre-approved (by your local continuing education committee) travel or work earns 10 clock hours – up to a maximum of 30 clock hours – within the five-year relicensure period except as waived by the committee per state rules.
